





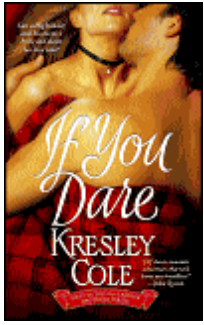
## BOOK CATALOGUE – JUNE 2005
